The Baccalaureate program in Nursing prepares students to give holistic nursing care to individuals and families. The program emphasizes illness prevention, and the promotion and maintenance of health.

Our students have the capacity to intervene with patients in different stages of growth and development and with complex health conditions in the areas of medical-surgical, maternal-infant, pediatrics, mental health, community and psychiatric nursing. Diverse clinical scenarios, as well as the community experiences, are carefully selected for the development of the competencies required by the program.

The program is licensed by the Puerto Rico Council on Education and accredited by Middle States Commission on Higher Education (MSCHE) and the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN). The program includes a total of 125 credits. Specialty courses are offered in English and basic courses in Spanish.
